You will get a letter asking you to come to the clinic

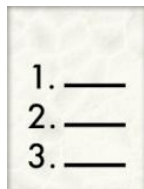


The letter will tell you when to come to the clinic.

Down's Syndrome Clinic



When you get to the clinic we will talk to you about what will happen.



You might have to wait.

You will meet the Nurse



They will ask you questions



They might take some blood from you.



They will check your blood pressure.



They might check your hearing.



They will test your pee.

You might meet the Dietician



They will ask you questions about what you eat.



They will check your weight.



They will check your height.

You might meet the Physiotherapist and the Podiatrist



They will ask you to walk.



They might ask you to walk up and down stairs.



They might ask you to do some exercises.



They will look at your feet.



After the clinic we will write to your Doctor.



We might need to visit you at home to ask more questions.

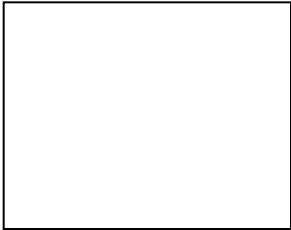

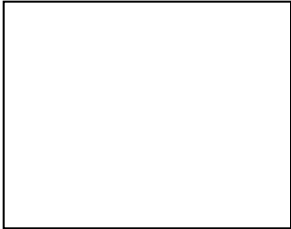
